## **Other Project Ideas for Student Government Groups:**

- Create a student government position dedicated to environmental sustainability
- Host a student referendum on creating a green fee to fund campus environmental and sustainability projects, dedicate student activity fees, and set up a match.
- Organize professional development session on sustainability skills and jobs for the student body or a national day of service.
- Create a campus sustainability plan focused on curriculum, campus practices, and community service.
- Certify the campus and community as a *"Wildlife Habitat"*
- Create student sustainability fellowship or internship positions with local employers
- Organize an annual rewards program recognizing students, staff and faculty for advancing learning, leadership and practices that advance sustainability
