

Saturday Holocaust Museum Tour

IMPORTANT: This tour is "self-directed." An ASGA representative will **NOT** be present at the museum. You should wear your ASGA name tags, meet up together, and then get in line on the 15th Street side of the museum. **The entire group has to be together to enter the museum at the assigned time.**

All visitors must pass through security, which includes metal detectors and scanners. Please arrive 15 minutes in advance of your reservation to allow time for this. Given the Museum's limited storage capacity, we strongly recommended you refrain from bringing your coats and bags with you.

If you're going on an ASGA-reserved Holocaust Museum Tour, leave to go to Union Station on the motor coaches at 12 p.m. (15-30 minute ride).

At the Union Station Metro Station, take the "Red Line" to Metro Center Metro Station and then connect with the "Blue Line" (going toward Largo Town Center). **Exit at the Smithsonian Metro Station stop.** It will take about 20 minutes to get from Union Station Metro Station to Smithsonian Metro Station.

Exit the station at 12th Street and Independence Avenue and walk one block west on Independence to 14th Street. Cross 14th Street and turn left; the Museum is the second building on your right. It should take about 10 minutes. See below to verify your institution is confirmed:

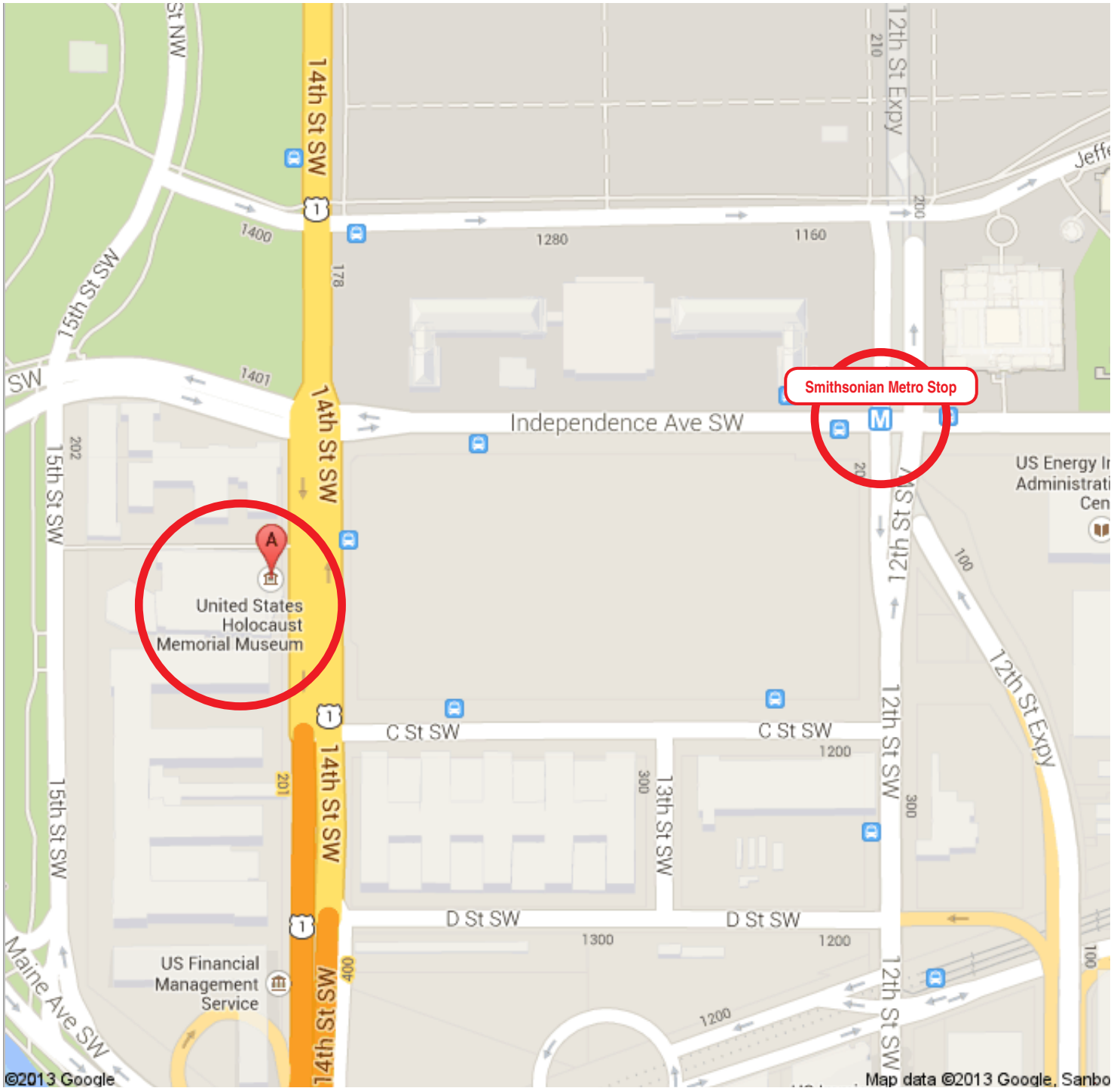

At Pentagon City Metro Station, take the "Blue Line" (going toward Largo Town Center) to Smithsonian Metro Station. **Exit at the Smithsonian Metro Station stop.** It will take about 25 minutes to get from Pentagon City Metro Station to Smithsonian Metro Station.

Exit the station at 12th Street and Independence Avenue and walk one block west on Independence to 14th Street. Cross 14th Street and turn left; the Museum is the second building on your right. It should take about 10 minutes. See below to verify your institution is confirmed:

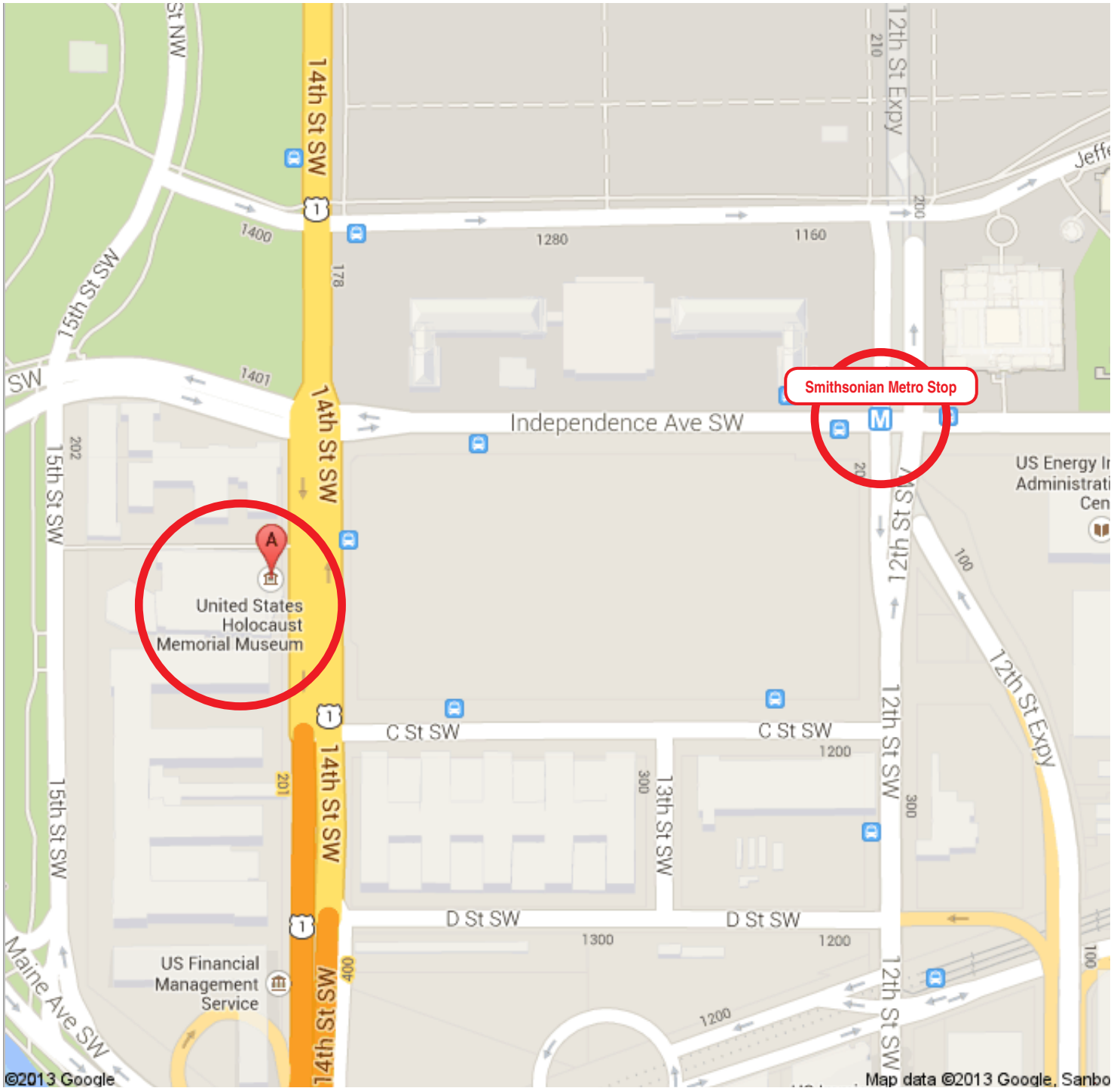
