

Thursday Holocaust Museum Tour

IMPORTANT: This tour is "self-directed." An ASGA representative will **NOT** be present at the museum. You should meet up together and then get in line on the 15th Street side of the museum. **The entire group has to be together to enter the museum at the assigned time.**

All visitors must pass through security, which includes metal detectors and scanners. Please arrive 15 minutes in advance of your reservation to allow time for this. Given the Museum's limited storage capacity, we strongly recommended you refrain from bringing your coats and bags with you.

You should leave the hotel 60 MINUTES prior to your tour time, and get on the "Red Line" at Union Station Metro Station.

Take the "Red Line" to "Metro Center Metro Station" and then connect with the "Orange Line" (going toward New Carrollton). **Exit at the "Smithsonian Metro Station" stop.** It will take 20 to 30 minutes to get from the hotel to the "Smithsonian Metro Station" stop.

Exit the station at 12th Street and Independence Avenue and walk one block west on Independence to 14th Street. Cross 14th Street and turn left; the Museum is the second building on your right. It should take about 10 minutes. See below to verify your institution is confirmed:

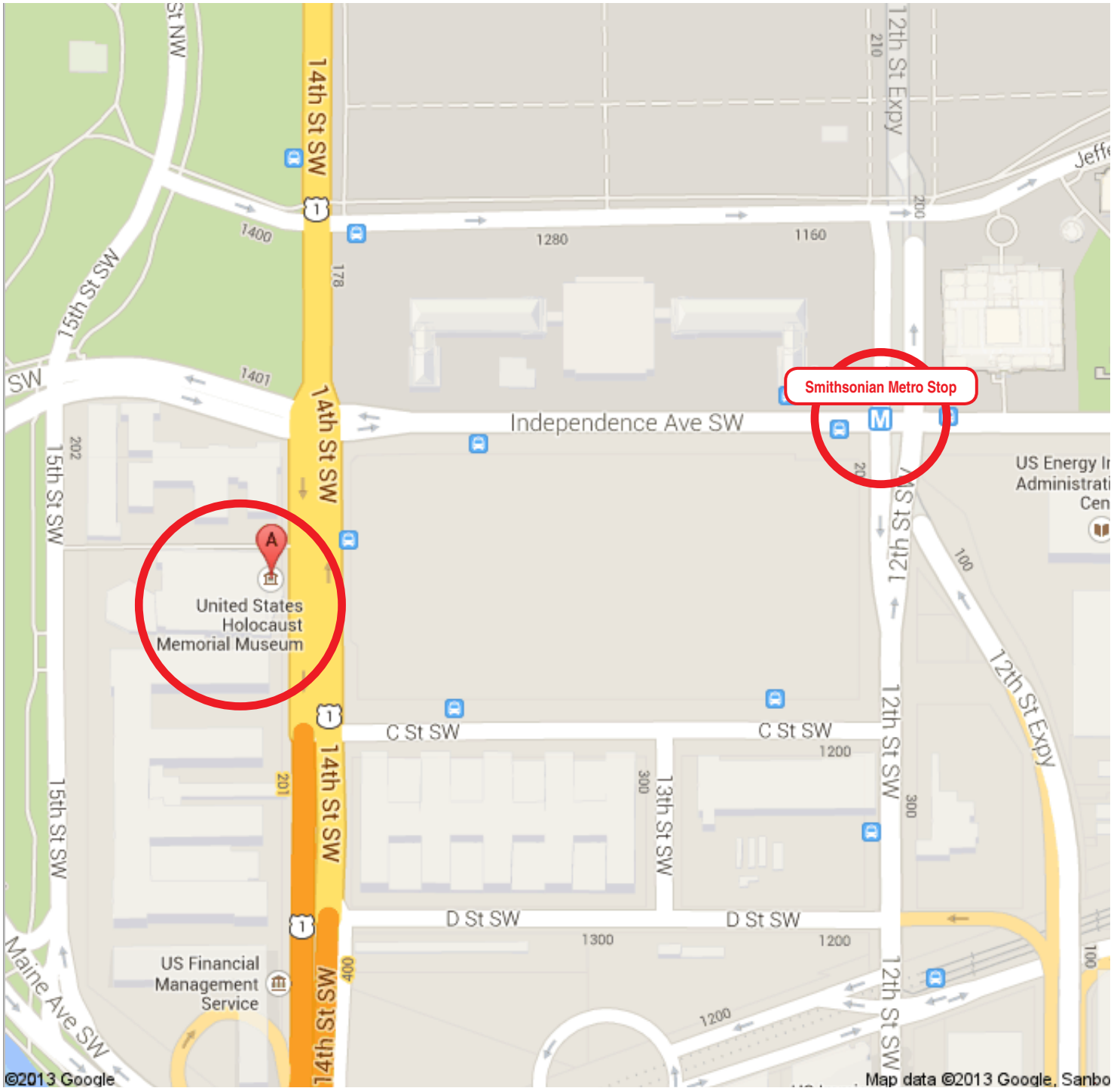
